

Abstract Submission Guidelines

All abstracts must be submitted via the AUGS Web site, www.augs.org/meeting. Abstracts submitted via fax or email will not be accepted. Abstracts must be submitted in English, and consist of a maximum of 3,300 characters including tables and graphs. If you already submitted an abstract for the AUGS Annual Scientific Meeting or the SUFU meeting you may resubmit it for the Fellows Forum.

The Abstract submission site will open on June 17 and close on July 30, 2010.

Instructions for Abstract Submission:

- 1) Have all of your abstract submission information, including an electronic photo, prepared before starting the submission process.
- 2) Abstracts should accurately and clearly reflect the content of the proposed presentation and be original scientific work.
- 3) **Each fellow may only submit ONE abstract.**
- 4) All abstracts must be submitted via the AUGS Web site, www.augs.org/meeting. Abstracts submitted via fax or email will not be accepted. Abstracts must be submitted in English, and consist of a maximum of 3,300 characters including tables and graphs. If you already submitted an abstract for the AUGS Annual Scientific Meeting you may resubmit it for the Fellows Forum.
