Help Your Patients Manage Their OAB Treatment!

The SUFU OAB CCP Smartphone App will serve as a "digital navigator" and will help your patients with their OAB management. The App provides patients with easy access to pertinent materials as well as other helpful features that will aid them with their OAB management. Features of the App include:

- Inputting of OAB medications with dose/time to aid in medication compliance.
- Automatic reminders for medications.
- Automatic reminders for behavioral therapies and pelvic floor exercises.
- Links to patient educational materials (dietary modifications, pelvic floor exercises and behavioral strategies, improving bladder habits).
- Bladder diary with urge severity scale.
- Reminders at specified time points for self-assessments (uses the PGII validated questionnaire).
- Reminders for cutting back on excessive fluids.
- Reminders for timed voiding.
- Reminders for future provider appointments.
